## LOCAL RULES

(Detailed description available on notice board)

### OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27-1)

All boundary fences and white stakes on the 1<sup>st</sup> (left) and 18<sup>th</sup> (left)

### WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26-1)

Defined by yellow stakes

### LATERAL WATER HAZARD (Rule 26-1)

Defined by red stakes

### DRAINAGE DITCHES

All drainages ditches are an integral part of the course and the ball must be played as it lies.

### CULTIVATED GARDENS (Rule 25-1)

All cultivated gardens are ground under repair from which play is prohibited.

**Exception to this rule: On the 6<sup>th</sup> hole the demarcated drop zone must be used.**

### PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES (Rule 24-2)

Protected young trees are identified by blue stakes.

### FALLEN TREES (Rule 25-1)

All fallen trees should be seen as abnormal ground conditions. (No relief for line of play)

### ROADS AND PATHS (Rule 24-2)

All roads and cart paths are immovable obstructions.

### STONES IN BUNKERS (Rule 24-1)

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions.

### EDGING GROOVE

Identifiable as a groove about 5mm wide, 10mm deep around the putting green. A player may without penalty lift the ball, clean it and place it outside the groove in the nearest position to where it lay - on or off the putting green, but not nearer to the hole .

### GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 25-1)

The areas defined by either white paint or the appropriate GUR sign are ground under repair from which play is prohibited.

### DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES (Rules 14-3 and Decision 14-3/0.5)

For all play on this course a player may use a distance measuring device only to obtain distance information. (Penalty for breach of this rule: Disqualification)

### DISTANCE MARKERS (Immovable Obstruction)

All distance markers on the golf course are to be treated as an immovable obstruction from which relief may be obtained. Relief may be obtained in accordance with Rule 24-2.

**EACH PLAYER IS REQUIRED TO HAVE A SAND BAG AND COMPLETE A ROUND WITHIN THE STIPULATED TIME**
